During the NLTP, we will recognize civilian employees and members of the Uniformed Services who have made significant contributions to the AAPI community. These individuals are nominated by their peers or supervisors and are honored during public award ceremonies at the NLTP. We will also present the Distinguished Public Service Scholarship award to support current students who demonstrate academic excellence, dedication to community service, and are interested in a career in public service. This year, the scholarship will be presented in honor of former Congressman Dalip Singh Saund, an Indian American who was the first Asian Pacific American elected to Congress.

FAPAC was established in 1985 as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that represents all civilian and uniformed services AANHPIs of all levels. We promote equal opportunity, cultural diversity, civic participation, and the advancement of employees in the government workforce through education, mentoring and development.
